## Your mission as Product Owner

The Product Owner is the bridge between the (internal) customer and the development team. It's a product owners' job to transfer the customer vision into a viable product by managing both scope, budget and roadmap(backlog).

In sum, the product owner is responsible for the overall process of making a project a success. This is done by making sure the right people with the required expertise are involved at the right time!

#### Accountabilities

- Updated backlog of product(s) and projects on priorities and a minimum of 2 fully refined sprints ready to go for development teams
- Make sure the MVP scope and budget is in alignment with- and approved by the (internal) customer
- Has scope-, budget- and quality accountability on all deliverables of development teams
- Production releases in agreement and acceptance of all stakeholders
- Updates required on legal- and commercial contracts, customer runbooks and project documentation.
- Translating customer feedback to business opportunities for sales, marketing, customer success or support.
- Real time reporting on project performance KPI's

- Coordinates and manages scope and priorities of releases for development team and deployment to relevant DTAP environments in alignment with customer needs
- Make sure requirements are discussed with CTO and
   architecture development team to determine viable technical implementation and roadmap sustainable solution
- >> Update (Internal) stakeholders when planning changes
- Defend the team from scope and planning changes (e.g., on customer request)
- Verify that questions from development team are answered in time, including involving of responsible customer(s) if needed
- Plan for releases to relevant DTAP environments for acceptance
